General Eligibility Criteria

- A scholarship application must be submitted by the student to the Student Scholarships & Financial Aid Office (SSFAO) before any award can be made (except in specific cases where noted below).
- A student can apply for several scholarship programs, but he/she will be granted only one scholarship (whichever is higher value).
- New intake students will be eligible for the approved scholarship discount for the
 first 2 semesters provided they register in 12 credit hours per semester. The credit
 requirement is waived in this period for students with conditional admission due
 language proficiency; after this period they must comply with the scholarship
 maintenance rules.
- A student holding an existing scholarship granted under previous College policies may continue to hold it, subject to continued fulfillment of the scholarship terms and requirements stated in that policy.



Rules for all Scholarships

- Scholarships discounts do not apply to remedial/bridging courses.
- Scholarships (including free seats) apply to tuition fees only and do not cover other payments (e.g. administrative fees, book fees, lab fees, incomplete exam fees, repeat final fees, etc.).
- Scholarships and tuition fee reductions are non-transferrable.
- If a student withdraws from classes during a semester without prior approval, this may result in the cancellation of the scholarship.
- If a student breaches the Code of Conduct or Academic Integrity Policy, he/she will forfeit any approved scholarship for the remaining period of study at the College.
- If a student provides false documents to obtain a scholarship, he/she will forfeit any approved scholarship and will not be eligible for any scholarship for the duration of his/her study.
- If a student suspends study for two consecutive semesters or more without a proper application, he/she will forfeit any approved scholarship (but may apply for a new scholarship on subsequent registration).
- If a student drops out of the College for a reason that is not considered to be force majeure, he/she is liable to pay the full (non-discounted) course fees of the final semester (and if the final semester is a summer semester, then also for the preceding regular semester).







Chairman's Scholarship

Value

100% waiver on tuition fees

Eligibility

Students who are UAE residents and achieved 97% or over in the high-school certificate¹

Terms and Conditions

- Five (5) scholarships are available, selected by the College and announced at the start of 3rd week of the Fall Semester. If more than five students are eligible, the scholarships will be awarded to the students with the five highest scores.
- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.
- Maintaining a minimum of 3.7 CGPA.

College Scholarship

Value

5% to 50% waiver on tuition fees as table below

Eligibility

Students who are UAE residents and have good scores in the high-school certificate, as per the table below

| High School Score | Other Programs | EMC /RC Programs | Additional Criteria |
|-------------------|----------------|------------------|---------------------|
| >= 95% | 50% | 20% | Maintain 3.5 CGPA |
| >=90% to < 95% | 30% | 10% | Maintain 3.2 CGPA |
| >=85% to < 90% | 20% | 5% | Maintain 3.0 CGPA |
| >=80% to < 85% | 15% | 5% | Maintain 3.0 CGPA |

Terms and Conditions

- Scholarship continues in following semesters subject to specific scholarship maintenance rules.
- Maintain a certain CGPA as shown in table above.
- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.

¹ High school grades stated are UAE government/US curriculum; equivalent required in other curricula.







Honor Scholarship

Value

10% waiver on tuition fees

Eligibility

Students who have achieved 3.5 CGPA

Terms and Conditions

- Applies in the semester following CGPA achievement.
- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.
- Maintaining a minimum of 3.5 CGPA.

Front-liners Scholarship

Value

20% waiver on tuition fees

Eligibility

Applicants working in healthcare organizations and their first-degree relatives

Terms and Conditions

- Healthcare workers to provide employee ID or other employment certification; relatives to provide proof of relationship and relation's employment certification.
- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.
- Maintaining a minimum of 3.0 CGPA

Student Relatives Scholarship

Value


10% waiver on tuition fees

Eligibility

New & current students with first degree relative(s) studying at the College

Terms and Conditions

- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.
- Maintaining a minimum of 3.0 CGPA







Social Responsibility Scholarship

Value

20% waiver on tuition fees

Eligibility

Students with valid government Person of Determination card

Terms and Conditions

- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.
- Maintaining a minimum of 3.0 CGPA
- Award confirmed after admissions committee considers application.

Employees Scholarship

Value

Employees 50%; relatives 30%

Eligibility

College employees or first degree relatives

Terms and Conditions

- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.
- Maintaining a minimum of 3.0 CGPA
- HR to sign off applications; only applies while in post.

Strategic Partnerships Scholarship

Value

As specified in the Agreement/MoU

Eligibility

Students associated with organizations with an approved Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the College

Terms and Conditions

• As specified in the Agreement/MoU.







Financial Aid

Value 10% - 25%

Eligibility

- Students who achieved 80 percent in secondary education final examinations (for first-year students) or a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.5 (for existing students).
- Students must submit an application for financial aid, with supporting documents demonstrating their need. Students must apply each semester and applications must be received by the published deadlines.

Terms and Conditions

- Registration at least 12 credit hours in long semesters or 6 credit hours in short semesters.
- Limited seats available.
