1993

1995

EIT offered the Business Administration and Computer Information Systems Diploma (Double Major) in cooperation with Northwood University, USA and Lambton College, Canada.

2003

The academic section was recognized by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

2004

The academic section was renamed as Emirates College of Technology (ECT). Also, ECT obtained accreditation for its two-year diploma program in Business Administration and Computer Information Systems (Double Major).

2005

Inauguration of ECT's main campus in Hamdan Street at the heart of the Capital City, Abu Dhabi.

Accreditation of ECT's two-year Diploma Program in Human Resource Management (HRM) by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

2008

Accreditation of, and offering Diploma programs in Banking and Finance, Accounting and Public Relations.

Established the faculty of Business Administration offering Bachelor's degree programs.

2015

Introduced Bachelor programs in Industrial Management and Applied Health Sciences.

Launch of Emirates College of Technology's Strategic Plan 2017-2022.

2021

Emirates College of Technology (ECT) is re-branded to Liwa College of Technology (LCT).

2022


LCT joined NEMA Education.

Liwa College of Technology (LCT) merges with Khwarizmi International College (KIC) to form Liwa College (LC).


















Cohort Graduation Rate


As per the CAA standards and regulations from the ministry, the normal duration it takes for bachelor students to graduate is 4 – 7 years and for diploma students is 2 to 4 years. Graduation rates are calculated as the percentage of students that have completed their program within 1.5 times the normal length of studies.

The graphs below demonstrate the graduation rates for each major and for each cohort mentioned.




Bachelor Programs Graduation Rate: Academic Year 2015-16








Diploma Programs Graduation Rate: Academic Year 2017-18





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
